HOW TO APPLY FOR THE SENIOR HOME REPAIR & MODIFICATION PROGRAM

Aging in place means getting the care and support you need to live safely in your home. The Senior Home Repair Program is available to low and moderate income New Mexico homeowners, age 60 and above, who live outside of Bernalillo County. Our program evaluates homes for safety and provides home modifications, essential repairs, and accessibility improvements to ensure that seniors can continue to live independently and comfortably in their homes.

Examples of Eligible Repairs:

- 1. Flooring upgrades or replacement to ensure the safety of the person, prevent falling, improve mobility.
- 2. Roll-in showers, sink modifications, sink cut-outs, bathtub modifications, toilet modifications.
- 3. Turnaround space modifications, door widening.
- 4. Cabinet development or adjustments.
- 5. Ramps (constructed to provide access into and within the home)
- 6. Widening /enlargement of garage or carport to accommodate primary vehicle and to allow people using wheelchairs to enter and exit their vehicles safely.
- 7. Grab bars and handrails.
- 8. Doorbells, door scopes and adaptive wall switches.
- 9. Other repairs addressing health and safety issues in the home will be considered on a case-by-case basis.

Homeowner Eligibility Requirements

- Applicant must be at least 60 years of age or older.
- Property to be repaired must be the homeowner's primary place of residence.
- The applicant's name must be listed on the property title at the time of applying. Additionally, the applicant's name should have been listed on the title for the past 12 months.
- Applicants must not be under bankruptcy protection at the time of the application.

- Applicants' Federal & State income taxes must be in a current status.
- Applicants must provide proof of income, and household income cannot exceed 300% of the Federal Poverty Guidelines. For more information about poverty guidelines please see the chart below.
- If the household does not meet the Poverty Guidelines requirement, we may consider other factors like unemployment, heightened food or housing insecurity, and eligibility for programs such as the Children's Health Insurance Program, Childcare Subsidies through the Child Care Development Fund Program, or Medicaid.

<u>Property Eligibility Requirements</u>:

To be eligible for the program, the property must meet the following criteria:

Location:

The home must be located within the state of New Mexico, with the exception of Bernalillo County.

Property Type:

Eligible property types are single-family homes, town homes, condominiums, multi-unit buildings like duplexes, modular homes and manufactured or mobile homes.

Maximum Repair Cost:

The total cost of repairs should not exceed \$25,000 per home.

Real Estate Taxes:

Homeowners must demonstrate that they have made current payments for property real estate taxes.

Mortgage Payments:

Homeowners must be up to date with their mortgage payments.

Healthcare Professional Evaluation: A qualified healthcare professional will conduct a home visit to assess the situation and recommend the required repairs.

Energy Efficiency Assessment: Funding for the Senior Home Repair program requires that the home be reviewed for energy efficiency improvements and upgrades. An energy efficiency professional will visit the home to recommend improvements.

These requirements help ensure that the program targets eligible properties and focuses on repairs that are recommended by professionals while adhering to the designated budget limits.

Documents needed to process an application.

Completed application: Fill out all the required fields accurately and provide necessary information.

Proof of age: Please provide a copy of your Driver's License or Picture ID to verify your age.

Proof of ownership and occupancy: Documentation confirming your ownership and occupancy of the primary residence is necessary. (See example of documentation you may provide).

Proof of Income: If you are currently employed, provide copies of your two most recent pay stubs. For individuals receiving Social Security benefits, include a copy of your Social Security award letter. If you receive retirement or any other form of income, ensure to provide the necessary documentation as proof.

To apply for the Senior Home Repair and Modification Program:

Download the application: The application is provided in PDF format, and you can access it by clicking on the link provided. <u>https://www.nonmetroaaa.com/senior-home-repair-program</u>

Be sure to save a copy of the application on your device, or print it out for your records.

Visit your local senior center: Applications will also be available at your local senior center. You can obtain a physical copy of the application from there if you prefer.

Complete the application: Fill out the application form thoroughly, ensuring that all sections are completed accurately. Provide all requested information to the best of your knowledge.

Attach required documents: Make sure to gather all necessary documents for verifying your eligibility. This may include proof of age, proof of ownership and occupancy, proof of income, and any referrals or recommendations from healthcare professionals. Attach copies of these documents to the application.

Submit the application: Use the checklist below to complete your application and submit it for review. We will respond within two weeks of receiving your application.

Approval Process:

The Senior Home Repair will review your application within two weeks of receipt and will inform you if your application is 1) eligible and complete, 2) eligible and incomplete, or 3) not eligible and is therefore rejected.

Once an application is both eligible and complete, the Senior Home Repair program will:

<u>Schedule a Home Visit:</u> A health care professional working with the Non-Metro Area on Aging will visit your home to conduct an assessment of your needs. The assessment will recommend specific home repairs.

Order a Cost Estimate: A contractor working with the Non-Metro Area Agency on Aging will inspect your home to prepare a cost estimate for the home repairs recommended in the assessment.

If the assessment and the cost estimate comply with the criteria of the Senior Home Repair program, your application will be approved.
